<b>Description</b>	Human IL18 (Y37-D193) Accession # NP_001230140.1
<b>Predicted molecular mass</b>	18.2 kDa

### Specification:

<b>Appearance</b>	White powder, Colorless clear liquid after reconstitution
<b>Purity</b>	$\geq$ 95%, by SDS-PAGE (under conditions, visualized by Coomassie staining)
<b>Endotoxin</b>	$\leq$ 0.01EU/ $\mu$ g by the LAL method
<b>Activity</b>	Measured by its ability to induce IFN-gamma secretion by KG-1 human acute myelogenous leukemia cells in the presence of TNF-alpha. The ED <sub>50</sub> for this effect is $\leq$ 2.0 ng/ml.
<b>Formulation</b>	Lyophilized from a 0.22 $\mu$ m-filtered solution containing 10mM PB, 5% Trehalose and 0.01% Tween 80, pH7.4

### Handling and Storage:

<b>Reconstitution</b>	It is recommended to redissolve in sterile deionized water.
<b>Shipping</b>	Wet ice (seasonal)
<b>Storage &amp; Stability</b>	36 months at -20°C to -80°C in lyophilized state 6 months at -20°C to -80°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution 7-10 days at 2°C to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution <b>Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.</b>

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
